



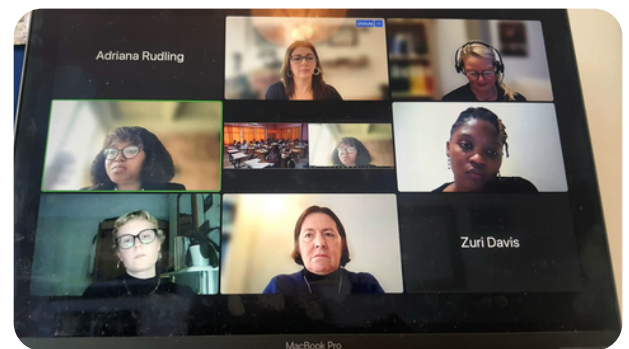
Indibano Victim Empowerment
